At ISCB, we complete our curricular offer with a Forest School Program, led by Forest School Trained practitioners. Forest School is a child-centred inspirational learning process that offers opportunities for holistic growth through regular sessions. It is a long-term program that supports play, exploration and supported risk taking. It develops confidence and self-esteem through learner inspired, hands-on experiences in a natural setting. Learning outdoors, holistically or organically from nature is one of our main targets as a school.

The School has direct access to its own forest of 30 hectares and the beach and the town of Platja D'Aro is a short walk away. Children will have regular access to our stunning natural surroundings during the school year through the Forest School Program and other activities organised by teachers.


